Plan Review for 876 3rd St: Property owner is requesting approval to construct a Cumberland Building garage. Plans need to be forwarded to Safebuilt for approval. Owner was not present. Request for Bird Study at Willard Park: Karina Sanchez would like to set up some equipment in Willard Park for research tracking birds within a rural area. Town Clerk did advise her the Town would not be liable for any damage to her equipment. Chief Clingan said if she would let his department know where she was placing the equipment they would keep an eye on it. Town Clerk will respond to Ms Sanchez by email advising the Board has no objection to her placing her equipment in Willard Park with the understanding Town will not be responsible for the equipment.

- Subsequent to this discussion, Town Clerk advised that town resident Brandon Baker installed a Frisbee Golf basket in Willard Park.

Continued Use for Existing Ag Access off CR 98: Owner of property is requesting a recorded exemption to continue the existing agriculture access off CR 98 from Weld County. Town Clerk said the access is actually in the county (south of CR 98 and west of CR 29) but with the agreement with Weld County anything we do or they do next to the border must be reviewed by the other.
