RESOLUTION NO. 2010-06

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE TOWN OF NUNN FEE SCHEDULE TO SPECIFY A  
MINIMUM MONTHLY WATER TAP FEE FOR UNUSED WATER TAPS

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees for the Town of Nunn is vested with authority pursuant to sections 13.08.210 and 13.12.010 of the Nunn Municipal Code to establish and modify by resolution rates, charges, fees, and costs with respect to water related services;

WHEREAS section 13.12.010 of the Nunn Municipal Code specifically authorizes the Board of Trustees for the Town of Nunn to establish by resolution all rates for use of water and for obtaining water taps and other charges in connection with the Town water system

WHEREAS the Town of Nunn incurs costs that are not susceptible to precise quantification with respect to low use and unused water taps;

WHEREAS the Town of Nunn already charges a minimum usage fee with respect to low use water taps;

WHEREAS the Town of Nunn at the present time does not charge any minimum fee with respect to unused or inactive water taps or with respect to water taps that have been turned off; and


WHEREAS the Board of Trustees for the Town of Nunn desires to increase the degree to which revenues from water services cover costs incurred to provide such services;

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Nunn, Colorado, this 19<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2010, as follows:

1. The Town Clerk is hereby directed to charge the full amount of the "MINIMUM USAGE PER MONTH/4,000 gal." charge indicated on the "Town of Nunn Fee Schedule" previously approved by resolution of the Board each month to holders of water taps that are unused, inactive, or have been turned off.
2. In order to avoid any retroactive effect, the charges authorized shall be first applied with respect to the next service period beginning after the effective date of this Resolution.
3. By passing this Resolution, the Board of Trustees makes no determination whether there is any legal distinction between water taps that are unused, water taps that are inactive, and water taps that have been turned off.
